Dance like there's nobody watching. Love like you'll never be hurt Sing like there's nobody listening. Live like it's heaven on earth.

My mother's life was the epitome of these words. She believed in its premise so much so that she had these words framed and hung just above her bed, a reminder of the precious nature of life and the importance of staying true to one's self.

Last year I lost my mother, but more importantly I lost my hero and very best friend. Tuesday 21st June marks the darkest and shortest day my family has ever had to endure. It was on this day her four children, eight grandchildren and soulmate. Don, lost their guardian angel. I know that for me personally, there will never be a darker day as I said goodbye to a truly beautiful soul.

From early on. Mum and I were inseparable. Though at times we faced extreme lows, the highs were truly awesome. No one could make me smile as much as she did. And there certainly will never be another person in this lifetime that will make me laugh so uncontrollably. Without a doubt, she was the person who got me when it seemed no one else did.

A BEAUTIFUL SOUL, OUR GUARDIAN ANGEL

My precious mother really did make the world a more beautiful place to be. She taught all of us what it was to be a good human being and the importance of giving of one's self. I feel certain that Mum came into this world to make a difference, to show us that humanity was truly magnificent after all.

In her eyes, her greatest achievement in life was becoming a mother, a role she embraced with all she had. And, in my eyes I am the luckiest person alive because she was my mother. I will never again feel as loved and cherished, as safe and protected, for there really was no other warmth like in her arms.

What was truly amazing about her is she wasn't just a guardian angel and mother to her own family. The truth is she was a mama bear to so many. I feel fortunate that I was not the only person to have called her "Mum". Fellow Variety Bashers, former colleagues, students and so many others regarded her as a mother figure in their lives. And, I'm so grateful that these people saw just how special she really was.

ALWAYS THE ADVOCATE

Her passion for life was simply contagious. She had strong values and would never let those be compromised. Most who knew her knew of her incredible commitment to the Variety cause, but her advocacy for children and any underdog for that matter, stretched far beyond this. Growing up, there was always a child who was not being given a fair go and of course, Mum was the one championing their cause.

Before leaving us. Mum spoke of her early teaching days and a defining moment in her career. In her younger years, she taught many underprivileged students and she recalled that during those early days there was a young boy who repeatedly attended her class without any food or adequate clothing. In her opinion, every child deserved the best chance at life. And in spirit of this, Mum sought to make his life better. She provided the boy with new clothes and ensured he had a nutritious meal each day. Just one of the many examples of her generosity of spirit.

And, even though it was a lifetime ago, Mum still wondered and gave thought to where this boy had ended up. Because that's the person she was.

HER STRENGTH AND DETERMINATION

Because Mum was a survivor and always saw herself as better off than most, she fought for her life and the life of her children when most would have given up. Her strength and determination is what made her truly incredible. They were what defined her as a person.

Mum was the sole reason her four children were able to attend private schools. To this day I have no idea how she did it. All I know is that she made it happen for our sake. Growing up, she was the one that went without so that we could all have the very best.

Not surprisingly, her ovarian cancer diagnosis in late 2014 did nothing to weaken her spirit. In fact, she was more determined than ever, rarely accepting help from others. She was still the mother, after all!

As the end drew near Mum's long time GP described her cancer journey as nothing short of remarkable. In all honesty, she was always living on borrowed time, though not something she would ever acknowledge. She treated each day as a truly precious gift as did her family. I was particularly grateful for the extra time I had with her. Though always close, our relationship evolved into something even more special during this time.

Mum and I have always spoken multiple times a day, but as she worsened we began to spend even more time on the phone or in each other's presence. I will forever remember those moments; they will indeed path the way for me becoming a better human being.

"BFYOU"

Mum always said, "believe in yourself" and "be your own person". In fact, on the day before she passed, Mum told each of us to "to remember to be ourselves". It was one of her last words of wisdom that she gave us and words that I constantly refer to as I continue my own journey.

In honour of Mum I ask each one of you to also go about your life in pursuit of this ideal. Don't try to conform for the sake of conforming or be the person that you think others want you to be. Instead, as Mum said in her departing letter to me, the people that allow you to be you, warts and all, are the right people for you. So be sure that these are the people you spend your time with.

She also said. "reach for the stars". Mum really did believe that all the people in her life had the potential to take on the world. So, in her memory. I also ask that you never doubt your ability to achieve great things. Mum wouldn't have had it any other way. When contemplating a new project or journey, be sure to remind yourself of what this little pocket rocket would have said to you: "of course you can, you will be awesome". I have no doubt either, if you knew Mum you were blessed with a little more strength than most. She was the person who instilled something truly special in all the people she encountered, and it was usually the gift of strength. Those that shared their journey with her are simply better human beings for having known her.

FINAL WORDS

Mum, the world is indeed a little empty and our hearts heavy now that you are gone. Though we can be comforted knowing that your spirit lives on in every being that you have touched. You have left your special mark on all your children, a mark that will make us better people and will allow us to live on through this immense grief.

Mum. It is my promise to you that you will never be forgotten. We will cherish every vibrant moment we had with you. For me it will be every time I see a pale pink rose, a daisy even, a spectacular rainbow or a child smiling. I will always know you are behind that wonderful gift.

To my beautiful Mum and the gorgeous lady, we will forever be in awe of you, we will love you to the moon and back, for all of eternity. Rest now with the angels our precious soul.

Cancer took my Mum all too soon. Don't let the prospect of a new day prevent you from following your dreams, telling those special to you how much you love them. Whatever you do, don't wait for tomorrow.

The Many Faces of Cancer symbolises this, as cancer comes in many different forms, touches many people, the people you see every day. It is not only the person diagnosed who is affected, it is every person in this room. That is why you are all here.

A little time has passed since we last met, and we have heard the words "I have cancer" uttered too many times since then, and watched those we love and care about face cancer head on and have lost some wonderful people.

You may recall in 2014 that we had a special lady in attendance, the unforgettable Diane Aston, who at the time was on her own cancer journey. Diane has since left us, but she is right here with us in spirit tonight without a doubt. Diane was not only our eldest daughter's teacher, she was a motivator and an inspiration, and a very cool lady who fought the good battle, and she will forever be on my shoulder.

There are but a handful of people you meet who can leave a massive footprint in your life, however our dear friend Mark Loveday who was best described as the life of the party and an important part of the Old School basketball team was one of them. Mark said goodbye to his family and friends at the tender age of 46, the age that many of us are here tonight, just a few months ago. Mark was a friend to everyone and when you were in his presence, he had an amazing ability to ensure that a great time was had by all. Mark brought endless laughter and love to Henri and to many of his friends who are here this evening. When your laughter fills the room this evening I know Mark will be here too, so lets raise a drink to Mark.


